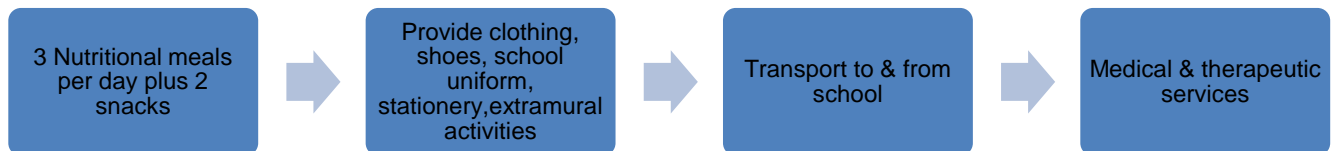


Leliebloem House Wish list Categories

Leliebloem House Children's Home is a residential child and youth care centre with an NPO number 003-227 that renders services to 60 children from the ages of 4 years to 18 years in a residential care program. These children are placed into this alternative care program by the children's court because they have been found in need of care and protection, and services in the community are not accessible.

Our residential care program provides the following:



The Nutritional Needs of the children are particularly important to consider as they are a fundamental part of the care provided which promotes overall wellness. We do our utmost to prepare a well-balanced diet depending on our budget and food donations received on a weekly and monthly basis.

Security: Night time security to secure our facility in the evenings Monday to Sunday from 18:00 – 0:600

Toiletries: for boys and girls: Tooth paste, shampoo, roll-on, deodorant, hair oil & straightener, body soap, facial soap and cream, body lotion, body & talcum powder and sanitary towels.

Clothing: pyjamas, socks, underwear, bra's, shoes for the season, rain coats, winter fleeces, tracksuits, school clothes and swim wear.

Sports: boys and girls junior soccer kits, soccer boots, boys' junior base-ball gear, girls softball uniforms, girls netball kits & takkies, and bats, rugby ball, tennis balls and swim wear.

Recreation:

Arts & Crafts e.g. putty, clay, paint & brushes, news print, colour paper, cutting board & knives, moulds, plaster of paris, scissors, beads, string and anything else that can be used.

Other recreation needs: skipping rope, balls, marbles, tops, swimming pool equipment and games, skate boards etc. & anything that can be used to keep children actively busy.

Electrical equipment: kettles, irons, toasters and microwave ovens.

Linen: curtains, towels, facecloths, duvet covers, sleeping bags sheets and pillow cases.

Cutlery and crockery: glasses, mugs, big and small plates, pudding/porridge bowls, knives, forks, spoons, teaspoons and cutting boards.

Cleaning material: brooms, mops, buckets, dish cloths (*for drying and washing*), dishwashing liquid, handy-andy, washing powder, jik, detergents etc.

Food: porridge, milk, sugar, rice, vegetables and fruit, meat (*chicken, beef, sausage, mince, fish etc.*), bread, margarine, sandwich spreads, eggs, cheese, pasta, yogurt, spices, sauces, chips, ice cream, anything

Food Hampers: during the school holidays & out-weekends (at least 25).

Disposing of various rubble

Fixing of ceiling boards

Fixing of lights

Service of vehicles

Painting of cottages

Stationery: pens, pencils, crayons, pritt or glue-sticks, cello tape, colour and white A4 pages, Koki's, wrapping paper, plastic, rulers, calculators, paper-punches, staplers, scissors, colouring pens, poster paper, colouring books, writing books, diaries, homework books etc.
